## STUDENT DROP OFF & PICK UP



Students are dropped off at the door no sooner than 5 min before the start of class. Their teacher will greet them there! Students will leave through the side door to help with the flow of people & traffic. For students under the age of 8, parents may accompany them to the entrance as the lobby is closed.



## TEMPERATURE CHECKS & SCREENING

A screening checklist and temperature checks will be done at the entrance for all staff and students with a no-touch infrared thermometer. If anyone has a temperature of over 100 they will not be permitted to enter the building.



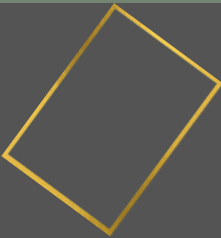
## INCREASED HYGIENE PRACTICES

All students and staff members will either wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer before they enter the class room and when they exit the class. Water fountains are closed, so bring your own re-usable bottle! No food can be consumed in the building. The lobby is marked with pathways to facilitate movement of dancers to restrooms and studios.



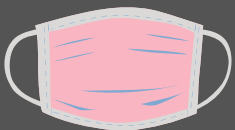
## PERSONAL SPACE & ITEMS

Each student will place his or her personal items in an individually provided sanitized basket (approx. 12"x12"x6") Please only bring the items that you truly need for class! All unnecessary items have been removed from the dance rooms, hallways & lobby.



## PHYSICAL DISTANCING DURING CLASS

Classrooms are marked with gridded boundaries to maintain physical distancing. Once they enter a studio students set their basket in a designated distance area, and go directly to a square on the floor. Curriculum adjustments have been put in place to limit interactions with less than 6 feet of distance between individuals.



## MASKS REQUIRED

Per the Mayor's order 7-8-20, all who enter the building must wear a mask. Masks are required any time dancers are not in their individual dance space. Students are encouraged to wear their masks as much as possible when dancing. When dancers are traveling outside of their individual dance space, masks must be worn. Exceptions are made for our youngest dancers who have difficulty keeping their masks on. Further details on mask requirements is communicated at registration.
